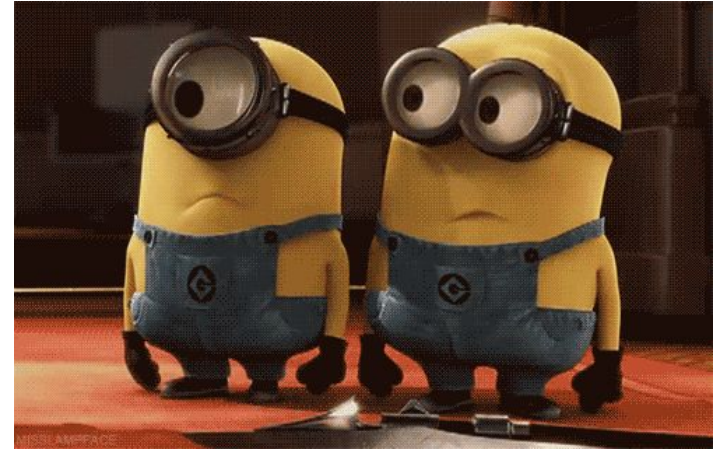

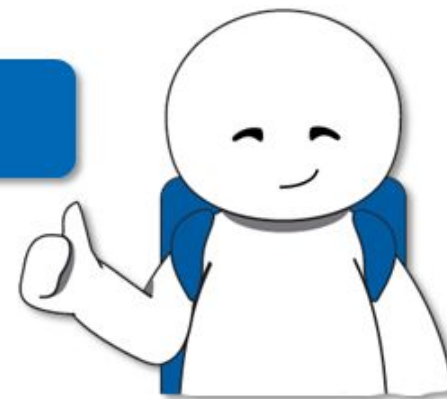
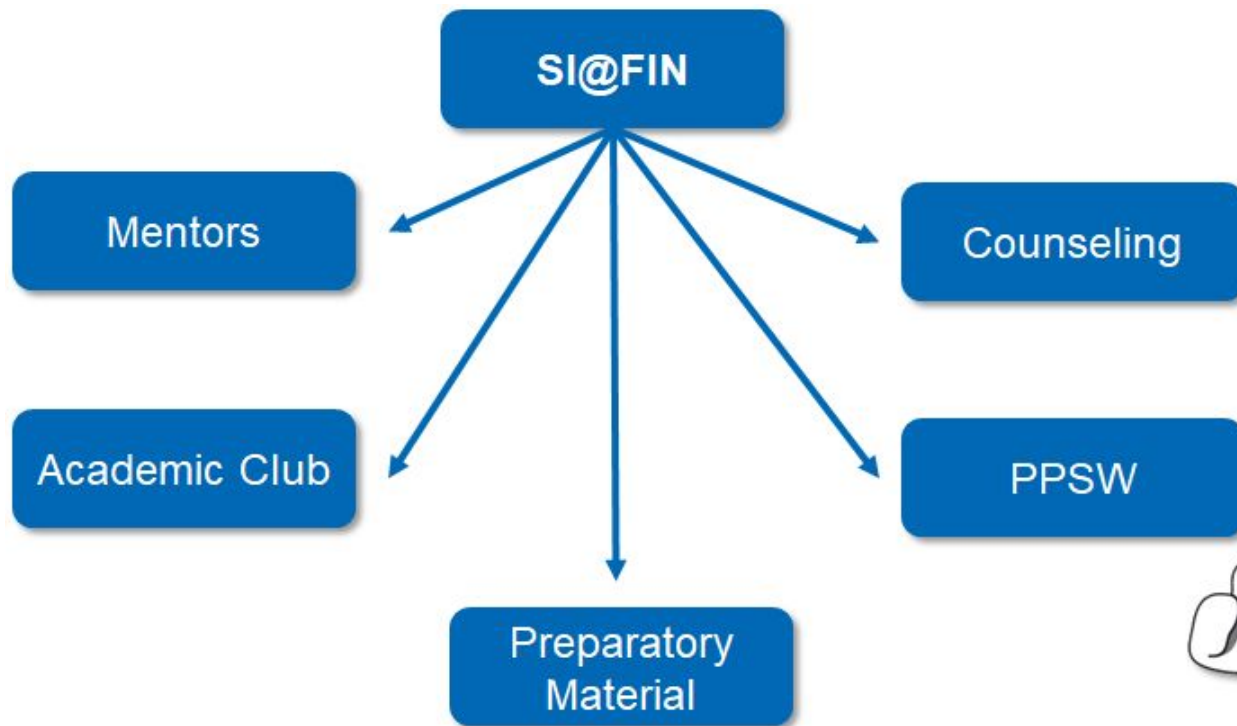

- Complete the puzzle and guess the personality

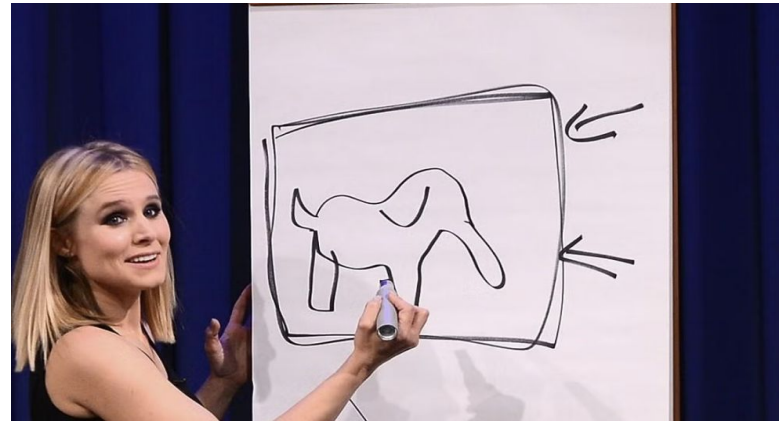


# Scribbled Relay

# Creative Tales

- **Master's night**

## Rules :

- A specific theme will be assigned to the group
- Each member must incorporate at least one word related to the theme into their sentence
- Each participant is required to contribute one sentence to the story during their turn



# Sample play :

Four friends, Alex, Bella, Chris, and Dylan, gather for a unique storytelling challenge. They are tasked with creating an exciting narrative by incorporating words related to the theme of "Cyber Adventure" into their sentences. Each participant must contribute one sentence to the evolving story, ensuring a cohesive and imaginative storyline.

Alex, incorporating the **word "data"** into their sentence, "In the neon-lit city of NeoArc, a group of hackers planned to steal sensitive data from the government's mainframe."

Bella, follows suit, incorporating the **word "encryption"** into her sentence, "Their leader, a skilled coder named Zephyr, devised a complex encryption system to bypass the city's robust security protocols."

The friends continue taking turns, each contributing a piece to the evolving narrative, creating a thrilling cyber adventure filled with suspense, innovation, and a dash of digital magic. As they conclude their storytelling game, they share a sense of accomplishment and camaraderie, having woven an engaging tale of daring escapades in the world of Cyber Adventure.

# SIMILARITY SEARCH
